

Bareq and Its Alignment with Qatari Schools

Bareq is designed to align with national and regional curricula specializing in Arabic for non-native speakers. A notable example is the accredited Kalemon formal education curriculum in Qatar, which is specifically designed to teach Arabic to students who do not speak it as their first language.
